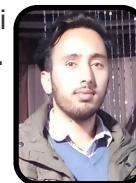

The researcher has published many research papers in national & international peer reviewed journals indexed in SCI & SCOPUS. The candidate documented the lesser-known language, namely Sarazi, linguistically, which falls under the Indo-Aryan language family. This is the first time documentation of the Sarazi language, and his thesis will help the future researchers to save endangered and vulnerable languages of India. He acknowledged the ICSSR, Govt. of India, for the grant, he received as a Project Research Assistant.
