Bharat Ratna, is the India's highest civilian award. Untill 2011, the official criteria for awarding the Bharat Ratna was 'for the highest degrees of national services. This Service includes, artistic literary and scientific achievements, as well as recognition of public service of highest order'. In December 2011, the Gol modified the criteria to allow sports persons to receive the award. So far three eminent scientists have been awarded Bharat Ratna: Sir C.V. Raman, Dr. A.P.J.
