Cultural Activities of University

In 2014, the University formulated Student Affairs Council to increase students' participation and all round development. The Dean of Students Dr. Yugal Khajuria conducted elections with his team. The Board of Cultural Activities got their first General Secretary Mr. Mayur Dhaliwal and Cultural Secretary Mr. Ashwani Singh. The responsibility of mentoring the student team was jointly shared by Dr.Varun Tripathi President BCA and Mr. Anil Bhardwaj Vice President BCA.

The Board started its activities with celebration of 68th Independence day. The students presented a cultural program alongwith Vikalp members of the university. This year a talent hunt show was organized as an initiative to get all the students show their talent. The competition (meant for encouraging the new talent & finding the multi-talented students) comprised of two rounds. Out of about 100 participants in the categories: Music, Dance, Literary & fine arts, in first round, about 26 were shortlisted for the second round. In the second round, all the selected participants (from round 1) had to perform in minimum 3 out of 4 categories. Finally, 10 students comprising of five male and female students each from First year Karan Sapolia, Akash Gupta, Kaushal Suman, Swapnil, Sahil Thappa, Divya, Aman, Shalini, Sonal and Nidhi were selected for Concordance -2014. Concordance was organized by BCA for First year students. Vice Chancellor Prof. Sudhir K. Jain presided over the function. The function was followed by orientation programme to familiarize the freshers with the academic and extracurricular activities and facilities of the University. The Deans of different Faculties and the Dean of Students addressed the students regarding the academic and extracurricular activities of the University.

The BCA also organized Hindi Pakhwara from 14th September 2014 to 28th September 2014 and organized different activities.

During the reporting perid NATRANG collaborated with University for many innovative theatrical performances. The first in the series was RICHARD-III followed by Oliver Twist and in July Matilda and Remix. All the plays were directed and adapted by Ms. Arushi Thakur. Shri Balwant Thakur has been the guiding spirit for these performances.

The Board of Cultural Activities organised Resurgence 2015 from 3rd to 5th April 2015 comprising of events in several different categories like Literary, Fine Arts, Music, Theatre and dance. The main highlights of the fest were Western Vocal, Legendary Drama, Fashion Show and many more. The Annual Cultural and Sports Festival of University concluded with an beguiling performance by the Qawwali team. Sh. Balwant Thakur, Director Natrang and Director ICCR, was the chief quest of the valedictory function organized in the Matrika auditorium on 6th April. In the valedictory function, Dr. V. K. Tripathi, President BCA, informed about the cultural events which started with Spot Hidden Talent way back in the month of February and in the early March, Essay Writing was conducted. After these events the stress shifted on the events like Face Painting, Mea Culpa, Street Play, etc.. While presenting a brief report on the organization of cultural events, Dr. A. K. Sharma, President BSA and Dr. Sandeep Bhougal, Vice President, BSA introduced the spectrum of sports events that showcased Resurgence 2015. SMVDU bagged the Chancellor's trophy for being overall winner in the Inter-University competition of cultural events.



Fund Raising for National Federation of the Blind (NFB)





SMVDU offers following facilities to the recruiters:



Network Centre

Network Centre, SMVDU acts as the pivotal for providing the network and Internet services across the Campus with 24x7 availability. SMVD University Network (UnivNet) covers all Academic building, Hostels, Administrative Offices, Auditorium, VC Residence, Central Workshop, Medical Aid Centre, Guesthouse, faculty and staff residences. The network and internet services of the SMVD UnivNet are backed by CISCO 4507R layer 3 Core Switch, 35 Nos CISCO Layer 2 distribution Switches, CISCO Pix Firewalls for security, Central Authentication Gateway and Network Management System. Uninterrupted Internet facilities have been provided across the campus with 60 Mbps internet leased line connectivity from Reliance Communications and 1 Gbps National Knowledge Network connectivity from BSNL under NMEICT (National Mission on Education through Information & Communication Technology) programme.

All 31 Academic & Residential buildings across campus are directly connected to the Network Centre through Optical Fibre Cable. This OFC links serves as Back bone for providing the LAN Connectivity to more than 1200 LAN Points in these buildings.

With the use of NKN (National Knowledge Network), Network Centre provide various facilities like video conferencing, virtual classroom facility which enables co-sharing of information such as lectures, presentations and handouts with other institutions. Within 2013-14, eight online workshops from IIT Bombay have been conducted at SMVDU under NMEICT with the use of

virtual classroom namely AVIEW. This mode has opened a new arena of providing online teaching / orientation to the students / faculty of SMVDU by the Professors from IIT's, IISc's.

Network Centre houses 18 Dell / Sun / IBM servers (DHCP, DNS, Proxy, Domain controller(smvdu.ac.in), Virtualization Server, Web server(www.smvdu.ac.in), Intranet Server(intranet.smvdu.ac.in), Symantec Antivirus Server, Library Server(Libsys), Application servers for School of Mechanical Engineering, College of Management) running on latest operating system software like Ms Windows 2008R2, Red Hat Linux and Ubuntu.

Network Centre holds Campus Agreements with top notch companies like Microsoft, Symantec, Oracle, Inventum, etc. to provide the services to all the users through volume licensing.

The development of an Online course module for students of SMVDU is underway which after completion, acts as a central repository for all Curriculums of Engineering and Sciences stream encompassing the modules developed under NPTEL, MIT, etc. An android version of the same is also available so that Students can access the contents on their smart phones as well.

Under new initiatives, various projects are in offing at Network Centre including Bulk Mail Server, Unified Threat Management Gateway, High performance Computing Environment, Virtualization, SMVDU presence on Social Media, Campus surveillance system, etc.

Telecommunication Section

To facilitate the telecommunication needs of the SMVDU, University had installed latest 4000 V2.0E simplex IP ready Siemens communication server.

Through, 576 Analog Extension's (Expandable up to 1392 Extensions), 24 Digital Extensions, 32 trunk lines with CLIP facility on each extension. Locking/unlocking, DND, calls Pickup, Call forwarding, Polarity Reversal; add on conference (3-Party), the EPBAX system is providing24x7 telecommunication services in SMVDU campus

The voice mail is also operational in the system which enables the outsiders to reach any extension without any help from operator. We have the latest call billing software which keeps the record of all outgoing calls.

All academic Blocks, Administrative building, Central Library, Medical Centre, Essential service offices, All Hostels, Campus, University Entrance, residential complex and external services like Bank, Post office, etc. are connected with our EPABX system through underground cable. This Underground telephone cable is laid in the entire campus to provide the EPABX Extension and BSNL land-line numbers anywhere in the campus as per need.

The IPSDLAM broad band internet connectivity through telecom network has been provided to various officers/officials in their offices as well as residences in the campus where LAN connectivity is not available.

The upgraded BSNL ISDN (Integrated Service Digital network), 512 line telephone exchange and a mobile tower are installed in the SMVDU campus for explicitly for the university current and potential requirements. This exchange has provided the lease line to various banks in the campus as well as outside the campus. The villagers in the adjoining areas are also taking the advantages of fault free telecommunication service.

Eight direct BSNL Landline connections are connected with our EPABX system for round the clock communication links from all extensions. Fifteen BSNL Landline connections are provided to various officers/ offices with tele-fax facility. SMVDU Telecommunication section have recently installed and integrated state of art, one 04 Channel 3G enabled GSM Fixed cellular terminal gateway with our EPABX system for continual communication services to all stockholders of SMVDU.

The telecommunication section with two highly trained technical staff provides 24x7, fault free services in SMVDU campus. Beside this, the section also provides a one roof, one stop solution for communication needs of all members of SMVDU family by Organizing "SIM MELA", a unique interface between all service providers of JK and SMVDU members.

The telecommunication section is committed to serve the SMVDU and its members with latest technology and services as per the international standards in future also. The section aims to maintain high standards of QoS

Publication & Media Cell

The publication & Media Cell acts as an interface between the University and the press and Publication of the images of the university through print media.

Medical Aid Centre

Good health care facilities are mandatory for any residential university. Medical aid Centre is providing services to all employees and students of the university. Independent premises with Medical aid Centre with better facilities is in place.

Staff:

Medical Aid Centre has three doctors (one lady doctor), two pharmacists, two female staff nurses and one laboratory assistant.

Facilities:

- 1. OPD Services: OPD service is available from 9 am to 5 pm.
- 2. Laboratory- a well equiped clinical laboratory with semi-autoanalyser is functional in Medical Aid Centre.
- 3. Ambulance Service- Two ambulances are available round the clock for referral to GMC Jammu or ASCOMS, Jammu in case of extreme emergency.
- 4. Ward-separate ward for male and female indoor patients.
- 5. Chemist- a well stocked Chemist shop is situated next to Medical Aid Centre.

Gender Sensitization Committee Against Sexual harassment (GSCASH) has evolved in the present times as a full-fledged institution for imparting gender sensitization and justice to prevent sexual harassment and gender discrimination in the campus.

Following the guidelines on the prevention and deterrence of sexual harassment in the workplace laid down by the Supreme Court of India in its 13th August 1997 judgment on the Writ Petition (Criminal) of Vishaka vs State of Rajasthan, a committee was constituted w.e.f. vide notification no: SMVDU/A&E/13/1290. The constitution of Committee was as under:

The GSCASH performs three major functions:
